

Report of Internal Quality Assurance Cell (Session 2018-19)

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In order to monitor standards of the higher educational institutions the UGC has established the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) as an autonomous body, under section 12CCC of its Act in September 1994. NAAC has been instilling a momentum of quality consciousness amongst Higher Educational Institutions, aiming for continuous improvement. The Km. Mayawati Government Girls Post Graduate, Badalpur, Gautambuddha Nagar has emerged as one of the premier government college of Uttar Pradesh with Under Graduate, Post Graduate, Ph.D., Post-Doctoral and Vocational Studies in different disciplines. The College has good infrastructure, well qualified faculty members, students with great potential and environment of teaching-learning & research by regular multidimensional interaction with internal and external experts. As an internal mechanism for sustenance, assurance and enhancement of the quality culture of education, Km. Mayawati Government Girls Post Graduate, Badalpur, Gautambuddha Nagar has established the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) for maintaining the momentum of quality consciousness, which is conceived as a mechanism to build and ensure a quality culture at the college level to meet the diverse needs of the stakeholders. The IQAC is meant for planning, guiding and monitoring Quality Assurance and Quality Enhancement activities of the college. IQAC regularly introspects & analyses its goals and achievements specially the gap between proposed target and outcome. With its collective spirit the institution achieved some new milestones in this session

1. Effective mentoring system has been implemented in the college wherein all the students have been assigned to teachers for guidance. The mentors (teachers) have all the information related to their mentees (students) allocated to them so if the students have any challenges related to their studies they can resolve it through their mentors.
2. Ten Certificate courses have commenced in the college from November and all of these courses are approved by the Chaudhary Charan Singh University Meerut.

All the conveners and team of particular course design curriculum/ content objectively, so it's become a prototype effort for rest of the colleges which come under the University.

3. Two Bachelor of Vocational Course entitled "Airline, Tourism and Hospitality Management (ATHM) & Medical Lab and Molecular Diagnostic Technology (MDMT)" has been introduced and commenced effectively. The college has got grants for the above courses from University Grants Commission, New Delhi.
4. Commencement of M.Sc.–Zoology with paperless teaching and internal examination facilities.
5. Organized a successful National Seminar on 'Information Explosions and the 21st Century Youth: Prospects and Challenges' on 21st January, 2019.
6. Renovation of 4 smart class rooms has been completed.
7. Two wheel chairs for differently abled persons in the college which were donated by Lions Club Noida.
8. Construction of three big rooms with temporary roof has been done and these rooms have been allocated to NCC, NSS & Rangers.
9. Thorough cleaning of college campus has been done to maintain Green and clean campus.
10. Compost pit has been created in college and is being utilized successfully.
11. Proper establishment of waste segregation, detailed green audit report has been published.
12. MOU has been signed for waste paper recycling with JAAGRUTI. 1,500 Kg of waste paper has been taken by them and in exchange of that paper rim has been given to college.

17. Establishment of sanitary pad vending & disposal of used sanitary napkins machine was done by a Noida based NGO.
18. Establishment of Day Care Centre (crèche)- institution provides supervision and care of infants and young children during the daytime.
19. Beautification of college premises by Department of Drawing and Painting & B.Ed. faculty.
20. Establishment of state of art Gym by Department of Physical Education.
21. Ten sewing machines have been donated to Home Science Department by Navratan Foundation.
22. A self-defense program was organized during 24th -29th Oct 2018 to give training to students.
23. A quiz competition was organized on 17th Dec 2018 on laws related to women on the instructions received by National Commission for Women and the winners were rewarded by cash prize.
24. Various industrial and educational tours were organized by several departments.

26. A demonstration was given by Wordsworth Company to improve the standards of Software English language lab.
