
Minutes of the Meeting



Progress Report of IQAC

(20th September – 31st December 2018)

- Effective mentoring system has been implemented in the college wherein all the students have been assigned to teachers. The mentors (Teachers) have all the information related to their mentees (students) allocated to them so if the students have any challenges related to their studies they can resolve it through their mentors.
- 2. 10 Certificate courses have commenced in the college from November 2018 and all of these courses are approved by the Chaudhary Charan Singh University.
- 3. About 95 students have enrolled in the B Voc course. The list of these students has been sent to UGC and as soon as funds are received, classes will be started.
- 4. Renovation of 4 smart class rooms has been completed.
- 5. There are 4 wheel chairs in the college which have been donated by Lions Club.
- Construction of three temporary rooms has been done and these rooms have been allocated to NCC, NSS & Rangers.
- 7. To ensure college campus more clean and green order has been issued through quotations.
- 8. MoU has been signed for waste paper recycling with JAAGRUTI. 1,500 Kg of waste paper has been taken by them and in exchange of that paper rim has been given to college.
- 9. Compose pit has been created in college and is being utilized successfully.
- 10. Various MoUs have been signed in the college which are mentioned below

- 11. Two days workshop in textile was organized by NITRA Ghaziabad
- 12. Blood donation camp was organized in college premises on 1st Dec, 2018 with the help of Bhagwan Buddha Charitable Blood Bank in which free hemoglobin check up of students was done & blood was donated by students and staff of the college.
- 13. 10 sewing machines have been donated to Home Science Department by Navratan Corporation.
