

## REPORT OF THIRD IQAC MEET (29<sup>TH</sup> MAY, 2021) @ZOOM

The meeting was initiated by Dr Kishore Kumar and later on Principal, Dr Divya Nath welcomed all the members. She said that IQAC has been regularly meeting, even though online in spite of the very adverse circumstances of Pandemic. She appreciated that all their stakeholders of IQAC sparing their valuable time for the meeting which inspired college to achieve quality education. IQAC has regularly set the milestones and achieved it. Dr Kishore Kumar informed that the college has been awarded first rank in developing e-content and has approximately 900 e-contents. He said that college is regularly leading towards excellence. He started by stating the agenda of the last meeting. He further communicated that because of the adverse circumstances couple of targets were missed on this occasion but keeping transparency in mind, he is open to discussions about missed target so that college can work upon them to achieve in future. College organized approximately 25 seminars and webinars of national and international level and it has lived up to its culture of organizing a physical seminar too. College is also working upon becoming a job provider rather than the job seeker. He informed at college has achieved in completing the syllabus is online. College has also achieved first rank in online digital library of Uttar Pradesh. In addition to those five team members also secured either first or second rank in online digital education. He told that all the faculty members are involved in developing content which can be accessed locally nationally and globally. College targeted more MoUs at institutional and departmental level. At present college has approximately 10 MoUs officially and unofficially. College has signed an MOU with TNS for employability and workplace. National seminar sponsored by Directorate of Higher Education was also organized by college on 13th March 2021 in open ground to avoid or minimize spread of virus by following covid protocol. Six online conferences were held on Innovation and entrepreneurship to promote the culture of the startups among students so that they become job provider instead of job seeker in future. 49 students have been placed through placement cell. College has been sanctioned 5 projects through UP government. Call the procurement for these projects will be done through e tendering or GEMS portal. National youth day was celebrated on birth anniversary of Swami Vivekananda.

Dr. A.K. Saxena Congratulated on development of content and online digital library and asked the college to take Pioneer step in implementation of NEP 2020. He stressed on the challenging points such as implementation of skill-oriented course in rural areas. He also suggested some of the valuable suggestions in implementation of NEP2020.

Professor Sheri congratulated college for their achievements during pandemic. He emphasized that UGC is laying lot of importance on hybrid education. He told about ABC scheme. Academic Bank of Credit. He requested to post suggestions on UGC portal about hybrid education and ABC. Dr Shanwal from GBU, G.B.Nagar commented on the objectivity of NEP 2020. He said their students should be guided in making a better choice and making a better career for themselves. Therefore, teachers should play the role of mentor to their students. Ms. Bakshi indicated that our organization is working upon providing help to students. She said that our organization will identify meritorious students and provide every help to him or her to achieve their educational goals. It was collectively felt by the members of this meeting that implementation of NEP 2020 is going to be a huge challenge as lot many things are still not clear. Ex- students and representative of students also expressed their views and give valuable solutions about improving education quality in college and felt proud to be part of progressive college. Dr. Deepti Bajpai, Convenor of Internal Examination informed all the stakeholder about the proposal of conducting internal examination via online method. Mrs. Shilpi, convenor of career counselling, informed about the placement activities carried out by Technoserve and Medha in the college. She stated that placements have a started in college and it will end by November 2021. Presently one student is already placed and more are likely to be placed by August. Dr. Arvind Kumar Yadav informed the members about the startup proposal and planning and also apprised the difficulty in implementation of NEP 2020 in commerce subject. In the end, Dr Kishore Kumar expressed gratitude to all members for being present in the meeting and contributing with their views of improving the quality of education in the college.
