First meeting of IQAC for the academic year 2020-21 was held on August 29, 2020. The meeting was held online in adherence to the government guidelines due to the pandemic. 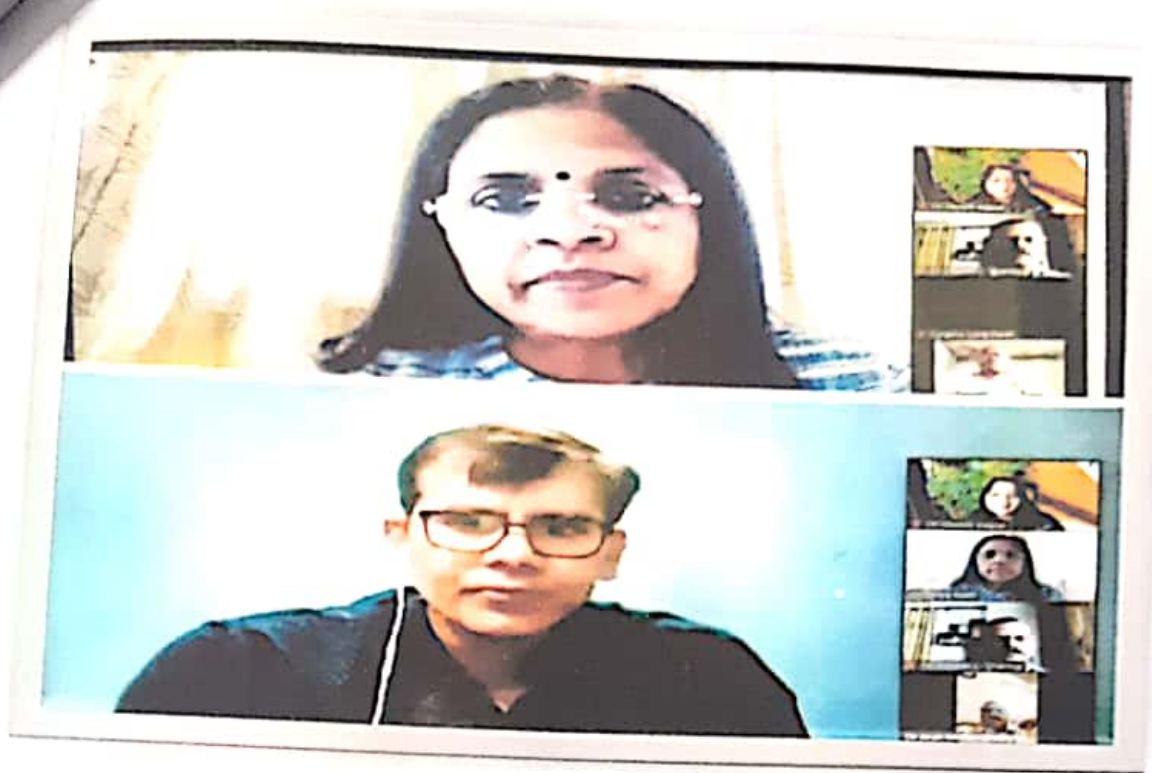

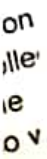
