FIRST MEET OF SESSION 2021-2022

1st October, 2021

First meeting of IQAC for the academic year 2021-22 was held on 1st October, 2021. The meeting was held offline after two years in adherence to the government guidelines related to the Pandemic. As per the standard structure of IQAC, Dr. Arun Mohan Sherry, Director, IIIT Lucknow, Dr. A. K Saxena, Ex Associate Professor, Zoology Government Raza College, Rampur, Dr. Vinod Sanwal, GBU, Greater Noida and government representative Dr. Rajeev Gupta, Regional Higher Education Officer, Meerut -Saharanpur Division, Meerut were in the meeting. Other participants of the meeting were NGO representative, Smt. Nargis Gupta from Lions Club, Sh. Sanjeev Garg and Manish Garg from Rotary Club, Sh. Chandra Prakash Singh as industry representative from Ambuja cement, Priya Bakshi as social worker, Dr. Jitendra Kumar and Gupta and Priyanka Shukla from Apollo Hospital, Shri Gyanchand, representative of Gram Pradhan, Badalpur and Sh. Arvind Singh as representative of the guardian. The meeting was also attended by Ex-Student representative, Student Representative, guardian and IQAC members. Prof. (Dr.) Divya Nath welcomed all stakeholders of IQAC. She also stated the objectives of IQAC. Thereafter Dr. Kishor Kumar, Coordinator IQAC presented the report of IQAC, mentioning the completed work in the current past and proposed the agenda for the future. Members of the committee discussed the proposal in detail and gave suggestions to improve the quality.
