ADMISSION PROCESS

- **Filling up of the Application Form and Important Instructions-**

The admission process is simple, transparent, and student-friendly. Just follow these simple steps:

1. Online Application Procedure

Candidates seeking admission are required to complete the online application process through the Samarth Portal.

1. Visit the Samarth Admission Portal <http://kmgcbadalpuradm.samarth.edu.in> and register using your name, mobile number, email ID, and other basic details.
2. Fill in all required information carefully.
3. Upload scanned copies of mark sheets, certificates, recent photograph, and identity proof.
4. Pay the prescribed application fee through available online payment modes.
5. Review all details carefully before final submission.
6. Download and retain a copy of the submitted application form for future reference.
7. Regularly check the Samarth Portal, registered email, and college website for updates.
8. Candidates receiving an admission offer must accept it within the stipulated time and complete document verification.
9. Deposit the admission fee within the notified period to confirm the seat.
10. Admission shall be valid only after **confirmation on the University-authorized portal.**
11. Without proper university registration, admission shall not be considered valid.

2. Important Instructions

1. Candidates must ensure that all information entered in the application form is correct.
2. The College shall not be responsible for any error made by the applicant.
3. Admission shall remain provisional until verification of documents and final approval.
4. The College reserves the right to cancel admission at any stage if any discrepancy is found.

3. Reservation Policy

In accordance with the State reservation policy, seats shall be reserved for Scheduled Caste (SC), Scheduled Tribe (ST) and Other Backward Classes (OBC) category candidates in all courses as per the following ratio:

Vertical Reservation

- I. 21% of the total seats in each course shall be reserved for candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes (SC) category;

- II. 2% of the total seats in each course shall be reserved for candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribe (ST) category;
- III. 27% of the total seats in each course shall be reserved for candidates belonging to Other Backward classes (OBC) category;
- IV. 10% of the total seats in each course shall be reserved for candidates belonging to the Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) category.

Horizontal Reservation

The college follows a policy of inclusive and equitable admission by providing horizontal reservations for specific categories of applicants.

- I. 5% of seats is reserved for candidates belonging to the Persons with Disabilities (PWD) category.
- II. 2% of seats are reserved for dependents of Freedom Fighters, recognizing their contribution to the nation.
- III. For Ex-Servicemen and their dependents, 1% reservation is granted.
- IV. Furthermore, candidates applying under the 2% Sports quota shall be considered in accordance with the institutional policy, which may include evaluation of achievements and performance in recognized sports events.
- V. Candidates should submit proper certificates to avail any kind of reservation at the time of document verification.
- VI. There is no restriction regarding the examination board. Candidates who have completed their qualifying examinations from any recognized board or university are eligible to apply.
- VII. There is no restriction on admission for students from other states, and candidates across India are equally eligible to apply.
- VIII. 2% seats shall be reserved for Single Girl Child candidates as per applicable Government rules.

Rules and Regulation

- II. Subjects shall be allotted on the basis of merit.
- III. Those candidates who do not claim their category reservation at the time of registration, will be considered as unreserved candidates and will not be given any advantage of reservation at the time of admission.
- IV. Admission under the NRI category shall be granted as per Government policy and prevailing regulations.
- V. A reservation of 2% seats shall be available under the CCA category, subject to institutional norms and eligibility criteria.
- VI. A reservation of 2% seats shall be available for Kashmiri Migrants, in accordance with Government policy and applicable guidelines.
- VII. The validity of earned credits shall remain effective for seven years only. After the completion of seven years, the credits will be considered time-barred and will not be counted for admission purposes.

For Postgraduate Programs:

1. In case of a gap (time lapse) after qualifying the eligibility examination, a deduction of 2% per academic session will be applicable.

2. After enrolment at the undergraduate level, the candidate must have completed:
- * 120 credits for the bachelor's degree, and
 - * The required 80 credits for postgraduate eligibility within a period of seven years.
